		Lesson Topic	Objectives
1	January 10	Introduction to Leadership	 Students will name at least three positive and three negative leadership qualities. Students will identify that Jesus led by including the excluded. Students will learn from Scripture that they can be a leader at any age.
2	January 17	Empathy	 Students will be able to define empathy. Students will be able to describe how to show empathy to others using the SHOE acronym. Students will explore Scripture related to empathy. Students will identify how Jesus demonstrated empathy.
3	January 24	Awareness	 Students will be able to define awareness, awareness of self and awareness of others. Students will explore Scripture related to awareness. Students will identify how Jesus explained the importance of awareness.
4	January 31	Effective Communication	 Students will be able to define effective communication. Students will be able to identify the difference between verbal and nonverbal communication. Students will be able to identify and define the people and responsibilities of each person in the communication process. Students will explore Scripture related to effective communication. Students will identify how Jesus demonstrated effective communication.
5	February 7	Community Building	 Students will be able to define community and community building. Students will be able to identify how community builders treat others. Students will explore Scripture related to community building. Students will identify how Jesus was a community builder.

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6	February 21	Introduction to Disability	 Students will be able to define disability. Students will be able to identify examples of disability in the Bible. Students will explore Scripture to discover that God has created each person with a unique purpose. Students will be able to identify two ways to interact with someone with a disability.
7	February 28	Disability History - Part 1	 Students will be able to name the law that gave disabled students the right to a free appropriate public education with their non-disabled peers. Students will be able to identify the year the IDEA was passed. Students will explore a story from Jesus' ministry through the lens of a disability inclusive leader.
8	March 6	Disability History - Part 2	 Students will be able to identify the law that protects civil rights for disabled people in their communities. Students will be able to identify the year the ADA was passed. Students will explore a story from Jesus' ministry through the lens of a disability-inclusive leader.
9	March 13	ADA & Accessibility	 Students will be able to define accessible. Students will be able to identify an example of accessibility in each of the following categories: employment, public services, business, telecommunications and community. Students will explore a story from Jesus' ministry through the lens of a disability inclusive leader.
10	April 3	Careers & Advocacy	 Students will identify at least three careers that provide opportunities to work with people with disabilities. Students will be able to define advocacy. Students will be able to identify three ways to be an advocate in their community. Students will explore a story from Jesus' ministry through the lens of a disability inclusive leader.

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11	April 10	Assistive Technology - Part 1	 Students will be able to define assistive technology (AT). Students will be able to identify at least one example of AT for daily activities, school & work and play & recreation. Students will explore a story from Jesus' ministry through the lens of a disability-inclusive leader.
12	April 17	Assistive Technology - Part 2	 Students will review the definition of assistive technology. Students will identify at least two examples of assistive technology for communication. Students will study a miracle of Jesus related to disability.
13	April 24	Final Week	Students will present their final projects.
